The emergence of Web 2.0, its tools and its connective, interactive, and collaborative features has prompted numerous discussions about its value and effectiveness in higher. Social media, especially Facebook, has infiltrated the student population, allowing them opportunities to interact with peers and academic staff as well as for collaborative learning. As one of the most popular social media networking sites, Facebook has reported over 1.26 billion users globally with university students constituting most of that figure. In South Africa, the social media landscape has seen a steady increase in Facebook usage. It was reported an increase from 6.8 million in 2012 to 11.8 million users in 2014.

CITATIONS NEEDED!

The aim of this document is to provide a guideline on referencing and citations depicting various information resources specifically for the nursing programme at The Western Cape College of Nursing (WCCN).

WCCN's referencing technique is based on the Harvard, author, date style of referencing. Harvard referencing is a system for citing sources in your academic writing. It is used by many universities around the world and there are numerous versions available. Most institutions have adapted the Harvard referencing style to their specific requirements.

WCCN's referencing technique is also guided by information from the following sources:

This guideline strives to explain concepts and identify the key elements that should be included when referencing.

In response to student requests and advice from academics, this 2023 version, contains some modifications including additional examples and illustrations such as Government Gazette, religious texts, and tables.

INTRODUCTION

A key feature of academic writing is accurate citations and references that acknowledges and give credit to the sources used. This helps to avoid plagiarism and allows readers to locate and verify the information (de Jager & Steele, 2016:1).

In Harvard referencing, you cite your sources in two places: in the text of your writing, and in a list of references at the end of your paper.

In the body of the assignment (Your answers): you will use <u>In-text citations</u>. In-text citations, within the body of an assignment to acknowledge and give credit to the sources of information or ideas that you have used. It's typically written in the format (Author's surname, Year: page number).

The <u>list of references</u> at the end of your paper contains all the sources that you have cited in your writing. The list of references is organized alphabetically by the author's last name. Here is an example of a reference for a book:

Smith, J. 2022. The history of the world. London: Penguin.

The guideline aims to:

- create an awareness for the importance of referencing
- create an understanding of the WCCN Harvard referencing technique
- explain how to reference the most frequent sources such as books, eBooks, journal articles and websites

When must you reference?

Smit (2017:5) specifies that you must reference when you are using words or ideas from:

- books and journal articles
- newspapers and magazines
- pamphlets or brochures
- films, documentaries, television programs or advertisements
- websites or electronic resources
- letters, emails, online discussion forums
- personal interviews
- lecturers or tutors (not always necessary, but check with your lecturer or tutor)
- reprint any diagrams, illustrations, charts, or pictures

Why should you reference?

Referencing allows you to:

- Present and acknowledge information from a variety of sources
- Show evidence of the research process
- Demonstrate the body of knowledge of which your assignment is based
- Enable the reader to locate your sources easily
- Evidence to support the points that you make
- Avoid plagiarism

What is Plagiarism?

Plagiarism is using someone else's work without giving them credit and saying that it is your own work (de Jager & Steele, 2016:2). There are serious consequences to plagiarism. Refer to your **programme guide for more information on the processes and interventions followed on detection of plagiarism.**

De Jager and Steele (2016:2) advises that you should always acknowledge the source of information and to use the following strategies to avoid plagiarism:

- **Quoting:** when you copy directly from a text- word for word. Quotes should be enclosed in "quotation marks".
- **Paraphrasing:** Put the ideas of another author into your own words. Do not include too many words from the original text
 - o Reword, rephrase, express in other words
- **Summarising:** Abridge, condense, outline, put in a nutshell

There are a few exceptions to these rules:

- Full stop or period:
 - No space before or after a decimal period, between numbers and multiple numerations
 - 2.5 million South Africans...
 - o R10.95
 - Subsection 3.7.13
 - No space when a period is followed by a comma or a closing quotation mark, parenthesis or bracket
 - Wilkes, S., Cairns, S. & James, T.
 - o etc.,
 - o (See Chapter 33).
 - A period before the end of a quotation mark. There is one space before the opening quotation mark and no space after period and the closing quotation mark. For example:

She said, "I love you."

- Colon: No space before or after a colon
 - citing passages from the Bible: The story of Josiah begins in II Kings
 22:1
 - writing ratios: 1:3
 - writing the time of day in the 24-hour system: 16:15
 - between the year and page number. For example,
 A stated by Smith (2023:35) ...
- Round brackets (): No space between volume and opening bracket and no space between after issue number and closing bracket.

It is crucial to remember that these are merely guiding principles. You might occasionally need to stray from these guidelines to write clearly and comprehensibly. For instance, to clear up any ambiguity, you might need to add a space before or after a punctuation mark (Canada, 2021).

IN-TEXT REFERENCES/CITATIONS

In-text referencing or citing refers to an information source, such as a book, article, website, etc., that is used in the main body of your assignment. It should include the bibliographic details needed to trace the source. Even when you quote, paraphrase and summarise, always acknowledge where you obtained your information.

Example of a cited quotation (end of the sentence)

"... Otherwise, you may be accused of plagiarism, which is a form of theft. If you are found guilty of plagiarism, you will be subject to disciplinary action, which may include being expelled from the University" **(Theart & Smit, 2012:7).**

Essentials of In-text referencing

There are three key elements:

- Author: Refers to a person/institution or corporate body who is responsible for the intellectual and artistic content of an information source
- **Date:** If there is no publication date, or identifiable copyright date, use the abbreviation "n.d." for the publication date
- **Page:** Page number/s are only included if there are pages, for example in a book or journal. Interviews, recording and online resources for example, don't have pages.

Examples of In-text citations

In-text citations should have an author(s) (surnames only) with the date of publication, colon, and page number in parentheses (round brackets). In-text citations can be found at the start of a sentence or can follow a direct quote or paraphrased information.

Example at the start of a sentence

Adams (2022:28) has argued this point ...

Example at the end of sentence

.... took place during the Fees Must Fall student protest (Adams, 2022:237).

In text citation with two authors:

When the authors' surnames occur inside of the brackets, connect them with the symbol "&"; but when they occur outside of the brackets, connect them with the word "and".

Example end of a sentence

"Staff varied in their opinion with regard to their impact of the environment as a cause of aggression" **(Bock & Pienaar, 2013:109).**

Example at the start of a sentence

Bock and Pienaar (2013:109) espouses that "staff varied in their opinion with regard to their impact of the environment as a cause of aggression".

Multiple authors (3-7)

When a source has three or up to seven authors, include all authors the first time the source is cited. Thereafter, the first author's surname followed by **et al.** is used. The convention is to italicise **et al.** followed by a full stop.

For Example

Smith, Muse, Bent and Bloem (2022:121) states that....

Thereafter, the first author's surname and "et al." is used.

Smith et al. (2022:127) validate the claim that...

It all ended well (Smith et al., 2022:129).

When a source has **eight or more** authors, the first author's surname and *et al.* is used every time the source is cited (including the first time). However, all the authors must be entered in the reference list.

Multiple sources simultaneously in a sentence

Order the citations of multiple sources by different authors within the same sentence alphabetically. It must be in the same order in which they would appear in the reference list. Separate the citations with semicolons.

Example at the start of a sentence

Several studies Booyens (2009:38); Duma et al. (2008:53); Geyer (2002:68) and Pienaar (2015:152) stipulate that....

Example at the end of sentence

You've done your research, you've made your reference list, now you're ready to write (Booyens, 2009:38; Duma et al., 2008:53; Geyer, 2002:68 & Pienaar, 2015:152).

Corporate bodies, organisations, etc.

In academic referencing, a corporate body is an organization or institution that is considered to be the author of a work. This includes companies, government agencies, non-profit organisations, and international organisations. When a work is authored by a corporate body, the name of the organisation is used in place of an individual author's name. Here are some examples of in-text citations:

If the organisation/group is identified through abbreviations

Example at the start of a sentence (First Citation)

South African Nursing Council (SANC, 2009) ...

Subsequent Citations

SANC (2009) ...

Example at the end of sentence, (First Citation)

..... (South African Nursing Council [SANC], 2009).

Subsequent Citations

..... (SANC, 2009).

Citing a paraphrased or bulleted numbered list

The citation should be part of a sentence and thereafter the bullet points.

For example,

Radwin and Alster (2002:62) highlights the following similarities in their findings:

- knowledge of patients' experiences
- behaviours, feelings and
- perceptions

Citing an Image

If you are creating a list of figures, right click on the image and select *insert caption*. Give the image a name. Thereafter, type the author and year in round brackets.

Note the information is always below the Image.



Citing a Table

If you are copying or adapting a table or figure from another source, you are required to cite it. Should you be creating a list of Tables, highlight the table, right click, and select *insert caption*. Give the table a name. This will appear on top of the table. Add the citation below the table. A sentence should precede the table.

The calculation of the mean and standard deviations of the data are obtained are presented in Table 1.

Secondary source citation

In academic writing, a secondary source is a work that cites or reports on the content of another source. This means that the secondary source did not create the original content, but rather summarised, paraphrased, or quoted it from another source. **Should be avoided. Always try to find the primary source**. If you cannot find the primary source, then you should identify both the original source and the secondary source.

Example at the start of a sentence

According to Pienaar (2013:152), citing Higgs (2003), "African communities in South Africa must participate in, and be responsible for, theirown educational development".

Example at the end of sentence

"African communities in South Africa must participate in, and be responsible for, their own educational development" (Higgs, 2003 cited by Pienaar, 2013:152).

WHAT IS A REFERENCE LIST

A reference list is an alphabetical list (no bullet points, no numbering, no indents) describing each source that you have used in your assignment.

A reference list is more detailed than the citations and contains elements that allow the reader to trace the original book, article, and website that you have consulted.

The reference list starts on a new page after your conclusion, and it must be numbered consecutively.


Figure 3 Cover of a book

About the Front Cover of a Book


- The front cover is the first of the physical parts of a book

- It has one purpose: to sell the book by attracting the right readers
- We DO NOT find Reference elements on the book cover
- Always go to the Title page and Copyright page or Imprint Page

The author refers to the person or corporate body who is responsible for the intellectual and artistic content of an information source.

Example of Person (Always Surnames first, then Initials)

Three or more Authors:	Bock, P. N., Magerman, C. K., Strauss, M. & Byrnes, T.	

Corporate bodies are associations, institutions, business firms, nonprofit enterprises, governments, government agencies, religious bodies, and conferences.

Example of corporate bodies

Soweto Trust University of Cape Town (UCT) South Africa, Department of Health South African Nursing Council (SANC)

NB! For Corporate bodies, organisations, etc. the full names are written out in the reference list.

For example

South African Nursing Council NOT SANC

Double names

When a maiden name is kept after marriage, and it is written Kirstie **Rendall-Mkosi**. The surname will be **Rendall-Mkosi** and the initial will be **K**.

Rendall-Mkosi, K.

However, when written as **Kirstie Rendall Mkosi**; the surname will be **Mkosi**, and the initials will be K. R.

Mkosi, K. R.

Prefixes before surnames

Some surnames have prefixes such as Van der, Du, Le etc. These surnames are typed as it appears in the resource.

For example	
Van der Walt	
Du Plessis	
Le Roos	
du Toit	

Author vs Editor

- Authors develop and research original written material
- Editors guide, review, and revise content
- A general editor usually supervises other editors (e.g., Mogotlane, S. in Juta's complete textbook of medical surgical nursing) or publications issued in a series (e.g., Woods, D. in Bettercare series)
- Editor(s) are distinguished from authors by adding the word (ed) for a single editor and (eds) for multiple editors

For example

Drydyk, J. & Keleher, L. (eds). 2018. Routledge handbook of development ethics. Oxon: Routledge.

Two or more sources by the same author(s), in a single year

When an author has several items published in one year, assign letter suffixes (a, b, c, d and so forth) to the year.

For example

Junco, R. 2012**a**. The relationship between frequency of Facebook use, participation in Facebook activities, and student engagement. *Computers & Education*. 58:162-171. DOI: http://dx.doi.org/10.1016/j.compedu.2011.08.004

Junco, R. 2012**b**. Too much face and not enough books: The relationship between multiple indices of Facebook use and academic performance. *Computers in Human Behaviour*. 28(1): 187-198. DOI:10.1016/j.chb.2011.08.026

Date

This is the year of publication or Copyright date NOT the re-printed or impressions dates. If there's no date on your resource, enter n.d.

For example

The Cornell Lab. n.d. Discover a new world of birding... https://rb.gy/oehxg [19 June 2023].

Title of a book

A title is usually bold and the largest text on the title page. A subtitle clarifies or provides context to a title. Only the title and subtitle [if any] of the book is *italicised*. It must be in sentence case, i.e., only capitalise the first letter of the first word in the title, proper names, and places.

For example

The Norton anthology of short fiction. Introduction to health care services in South Africa. WCCN NO 21 Referencing technique Guide

Sub-Title

Do not capitalize the word after a colon (:) in the title

For example

Sociology: an introduction...

The first edition is not entered in a reference list, only subsequent editions.

For example

Edition of a Book other than the first 2nd ed. 3rd ed. 4th ed. 5th ed. rev. ed. etc. are entered. Harris, L. A. 2001. *Canadian copyright law*. 3rd ed. New York: McGraw Hill.

Place of publication

The place of publication usually appears at the bottom of the title page in a book or on the verso of the title page. If there are multiple cities listed, select the first city listed.

In the example above, you will state New York as the place of publication for the publisher.

Enter the town or city where the publisher is based and not the country.

Publisher

Omit '& co' 'Pty Ltd', '& sons' after the name of the publishers.

For example,

Juta and Co. Type only Juta.

eBooks

An eBook or electronic book is a non-editable text that is made available on a digital format and displayed and read on an electronic device, such as a tablet or smartphone. The digital format can be ePUB, PDF or HTML (Gardiner & Musto, 2010:164).

Format

The reference list format for an eBook from a database is:

Surname, Initial(s). Year. Title: subtitle. [Name of Database]. Permalink [Date you accessed].

To copy the citation from the database

- Click on cite
- Scroll down till you find Harvard
- Copy and Paste in your reference list
- Adapt to WCCN Referencing technique



eBook as an ePub


The page numbers will differ from the printed version. Find the page number(s) by clicking on the Permalink.



When to cite individual Chapters

All books have chapters. However, if there are different authors for the chapters, you need to reference EACH chapter you use. Use chapter in book format when the chapter/s of the book have different author/s as well as when the person who edited or complied the book wrote a chapter/s in the book.

If you use multiple chapters from a book with different authors for each chapter, you still need to reference EACH chapter you use. On account that you need to acknowledge who wrote the work you are using, not the person who edited/compiled the book.





What you will need to reference a chapter in an edited book

Printed book

- Author/s of the chapter
- Date the book published
- Title of the chapter, followed by the word "In"
- Followed by a full reference for the book in which it's published, and finally the page range of the chapter








Figure 6: Example of an Academic Article (Kratovil, 2021).

Title of the article

The title and subtitle of an article are in sentence case and normal font.

For example,

Plagiarism in the graduate nursing program: occupation stress or lack of knowledge?

Title of the Journal

The title of the journal is in *Title Case and Italics*. The first letter of each word is capitalised. However, use lowercase for articles (an, a, the) and prepositions (at, by, of)

For example

Nursing Science Quarterly.

Note: Use title case for the title of journals, Conference proceedings, Acts, newspapers, musical scores, and official publications in the reference list:

For Example

Africa Journal of Nursing and Midwifery. Mail and Guardian. International Conference on Nursing (ICN).

Volume and Issue Number

Do not type the words 'volume' and 'issue number' in the reference list. Only the numbers.

For example

32(1)

Digital object identifier

A digital object identifier (DOI) is a unique alphanumeric string assigned by a registration agency. The DOI detects content and provide a persistent link to its location on the Internet. Although, a DOI is found on most electronic articles, not every article or resources has a DOI. When using a DOI, you don't have to add a URL and the access date.

In Press

Articles that have been accepted for publication, but which have not been formally published and will not yet have the complete volume/issue/page information, are referred to as In Press. Use "in press" after title of journal.

Essentials for referencing a Website/webpage

When referencing a website or webpage, it's important to provide accurate and sufficient information to enable others to locate the specific webpage you are referencing. The essential elements for referencing a website or webpage include:

- Author/(s): Provide the name(s) of the author(s) or the organisation responsible for the content. If the author's name is not explicitly mentioned, you can use the name of the organization or the website itself.
- **Date:** If available, include the date the website/ webpage was published or last updated. If not found on the top of the website scroll down to the end to find the date.
- **Title:** The title of the website is usually displayed at the top of the page or in the browser's title bar.
- URL: Include the full Uniform Resource Locator (URL) of the website/webpage. The URL is the web address that starts with "http://" or "https://" and uniquely identifies the location of the webpage on the internet. The URL indicates that it is an online source so do not type 'available at' or 'online' in the reference.
- **Date Accessed:** The date you accessed the website should appear in square brackets at the end of the reference. The format is [DD Month Year].




Figure 9 Example of a Website (WCG, 2022)

To find all the elements for a GG reference, you will need to find the GG it was published in. The elements will be on the cover page, content page and the page the Act or Regulation starts.

From the cover page you will need:

- Author
- Date
 - o Year
 - o Day
 - o Month
- Source
- Volume
- Gazette Number




Figure 10 GG Cover Page
