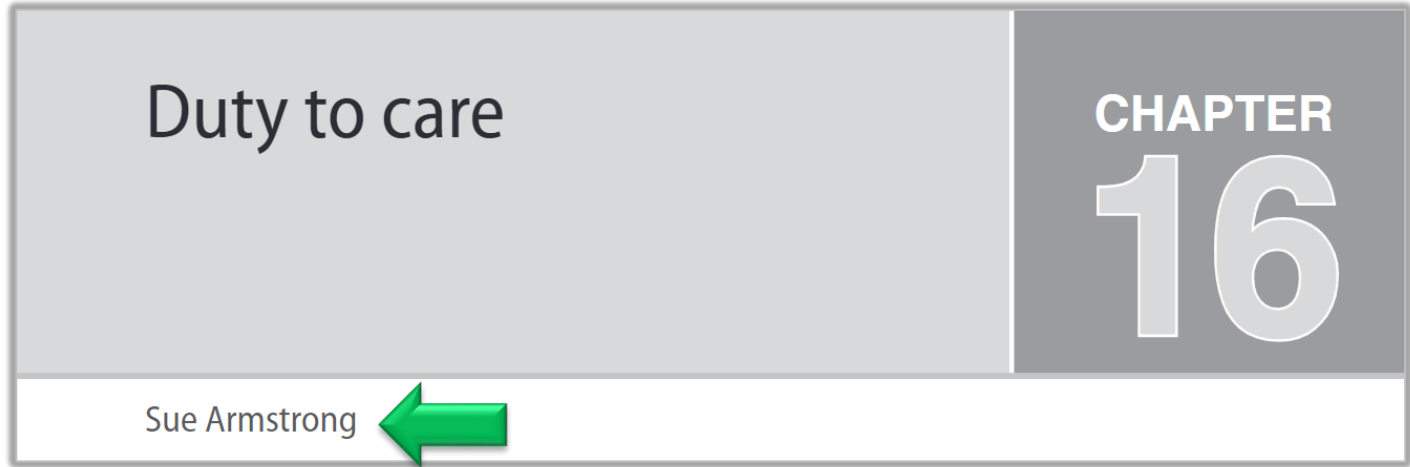
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WHEN TO REFERENCE AS A CHAPTER IN A BOOK

- It will most likely be on an **edited** book
- The different chapters are **written by different people**

For example



What you will need to reference a chapter in an edited book

Printed book

- Author/s of the chapter
 - Date book published
 - Title of the chapter, followed by the word “In”
 - followed by a full reference for the book in which it’s published, and finally the page range of the chapter
- *Editor(s) are distinguished from authors by adding the word “ed” for a single editor and “eds” for multiple editors*

What you will need to reference a chapter in an edited book

Electronic book


- Author/s of the chapter
- Date book published
- Title of the chapter, followed by the word “In”
- followed by a full reference for the book in which it’s published, and finally the page range of the chapter
- [Name of Database]
- Permalink First page of Chapter
- [dd Month Year]

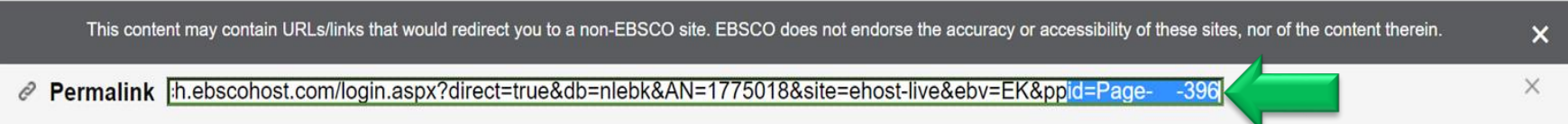
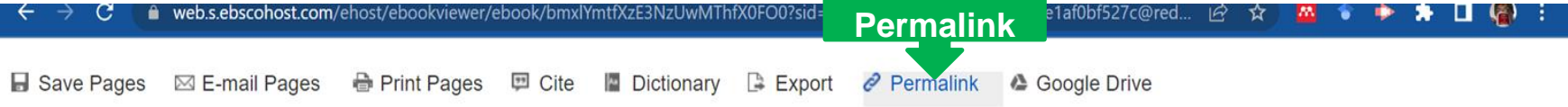

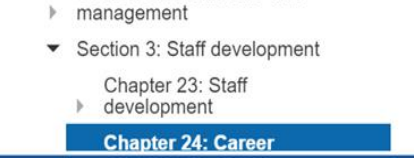
